2. General instructions for operating the machine

Read carefully the User's Manual before taking into operation the machine!

The washing machine can be used for washing the glass sheets of the insulated glass structures.

Do not use the machine for other purposes!

Attention:

To avoid electrocutation and other injuries:


- Do not leave the machine without supervision after starting it!
- Always turn off the machine before changing the mechanical or electrical spare parts!
- During operation only the authorized personnel can be near the machine!
- During work always use the specified protective clothing!


The liability of the manufacturer should be deemed to be void in the following cases:

- in cases of not using the machine according to its original purposes,
- in cases of wrong installation (or when the machine is not installed by the authorized person),
- in cases of faulty feeding,
- in cases of neglected maintenance of the machine,
- in cases of not permitted modifications or changes on the machine,
- in cases of not using the machine according to the instructions.

Use only original manufactured components for servicing. Breaking this rule may lead to fault, the guarantee should be deemed to be void, and all repair costs will be charged to the owner of the machine!!

The electrical parts of the machine are designed according to the MSZ 63/4-85 standard.

4. Shipping, packing

Shipping-storing should always be made in vertical position!

Each shipping is made on pallets, each part is packed separately, which protects them from the mechanical and environmental injuries. Each unit is fixed on pallets.

The units:

- in- and outlet conveyor,
- washing machine.

Recomended moving equipments:

- forklift
- manual hydraulic forklift

When using forklift you should take care of the stability of the machine.

After removing the packing check the integrity of the machine and the fix connections of the machine.

In case of defects or incompletion a report should be made – with pictures, if possible – accurately mentioning the problems!

5. Installation

Before installing the machine check the workfield:


- the technological connection points (water, drainage, proper electrical connections etc.)
- solid, horizontal, dustproof place according to the size and weight of the machine
- verifying the size of the place needed for placing and maintaining the machine (height, free space etc.)
- check the integrity of the electrical cables, connections etc.

After checking the integrity of the machine also check the horizontal position of the glass forwarding conveyor. After adjusting has been made, the machines parts should be fixed to each other and to the ground.

Connect the machine to the water, air and electrical network, fill the tanks with water, connect the grounding cables.

IMPORTANT!

Before connecting the machine to the electrical network, check the voltage of the socket, the right connection of the "zero" point and the grounding with the matching plug!



If needed you can adjust the correct direction by changing two phases!

Electrical connection:

- 1. Connect the machine to the network.
- 2. Turn the main switch to position 1. After this the machine gets under voltage and the lights of the outlet conveyor turn on.
- 3. The direction of rotation of the rollers might not be proper.
- 4. In case of wrong direction two phases should be changed in the socket!
- 5. After this other electrical adjustments are not needed.

Attention:

When changing the phases take care to your safety. Any electrical work should be made by a technician!

Check the tightness of the chain. After a quick start check the right direction of rotation:

- The glass transporting conveyor
- The brushes
- The pumps
- The ventilator

During constant operation you should check:

- The working of the water nozzles
- The sealing of the water blocks
- The position of the drying nozzles

During tests you can adjust the optimum position of the nozzles by putting

glass sheets of different sizes in the machine!

6. Set up, start

Before starting the machine you should check the followings:

- The integrity of the electrical connections,
- The sealing of the water, drainage and connections,
- The fillness of the water tanks,
- The state of the air filter,
- The cleanness of the work place,
- The safety switch.

If you find everything in order you can start the machine with the main switch and each function with the control buttons.

7. Instructions for use

Personal requirement:

The machine can be operated only by persons who were authorized by the owner of the machine and who suit the general work conditions, who were trained from the present User's Manual and proved to be competent to operate the machine.

The operator should use the specified protective clothes during work! Protective clothes: protective dress, gloves, glasses!

Opening the electrical box or touching the moving, rotating parts of the machine during work is strictly forbidden!


Moving of big glass sheets should be made by more people and using

special handling and safety equipment!

The most important is the clean soft water (distilled water) and the clean air filter! Use only CRL/Somaca Low-e detergent (3379046, Gal or 3379048, 55 Gal) in the wash tanks if needed.

In case of a problem, stop the machine according to the instructions and call a technician! Machinery Division Service Technicians, (866) 583-1377.

Using the SM70V Washer



- 1. After turning the main switch the machine gets under voltage.
- 2. The lights on the outlet conveyor turn on.
- 3. We can put the first sheet of glass on the inlet conveyor.
- 4. By pressing the green button on the START switch the glass enters in the washer.

- 5. If needed you can stop the conveyor by pressing the red button on the START switch.
- 6. The brushes can be started or stoped any time during washing with the on/off buttons of the WASH switch.
- 7. Drying can be controlled with the on /off buttons of the DRYING switch.
- 8. You can stop the machine in case of malfunction with the EMERGENCY emergency switch.
- 9. After you finished work, the machine can be stoped with the main switch.

8. Maintenance

The maintenance of the machine is needed to assure the continuous and problem free working of the machine. The first is the daily maintenance made by the operators of the machine.

Maintenance:

- Keep the area of the machine clean
- Cleaning or if necessary, changing the used filters (water, air)
- Oiling the rotating parts of the machine (chain, gear)
- Always watching the operation of the machine
- In case of malfunction notify the technician

Daily checkings before starting the work:

- Check the integrity of the cover of the machine, the cables and electrical connections
- The sealing of the water connections
- Cleaning and checking the water and air filters
- Checking the water tank levels and the cleanness of the water
- Checking the rollers and the conveyors
- Refill water tanks with fresh water

Weekly checking:

- The daily checking
- Checking the interior of the washing machine
- The state of the brushes
- The integrity of the rubbers
- The supporting and forwarding rollers
- Cleaning or changing any plugged water nozzles
- Check and oil the roller driving chains

Monthly checking:

- The weekly checking
- Cleaning the water and the drying block
- After removing the cover check the adjusting of the chains and gears
- Oil the bearings of the ventilator
- Change the air filters

9. Typical errors, possible causes

Error	Causes	Solution
The machine can't be started (the lights are not on)	Not connected to the network.	Connect the machine to the network or check the cables!
	No power.	Check the line power!
	The main fuses burned out.	Change the fuses!
The ventilator doesn't start.	No power.	Put the machine under voltage!
	One phase is missing in the intake.	Check the phases. Press the start button!
	The control is not started.	Pull out the emergency button and start the machine!
	The emergency switch got stuck.	
The water pump doesn't pump the water in the water block	The level of the water is low.	Fill the water tank.
	The water filters clogged.	Clean the water filters!
	The nozzles clogged.	Clean the nozzles!
The washed glass is scratched.	The brushes are not clean.	Clean the brushes!
	The rubbers are not clean.	Clean the rubbers!
	The rollers of the in-outlet conveyors are not clean.	Clean the rollers!
	Some of the in-outlet conveyor's rollers are not rotating.	Change the bad rollers!
	The glass is very dirty, oily.	For cutting the glass use only the proper oil!
The lower part of the glass breaks out.	The glass is very unity, ony. The glass supporting roller is worn-out.	Change the roller!
	The glass supporting roller is not rotating.	Take the roller out and wash it!
The small glass is not coming out of the washer.	The small glass stopped in the machine.	Check the size of the glass to see if it meets the min. glass size indicated by the manufacturer!
The 1/2" thick glass doesn't get through the machine.	The glass stuck in the nozzles.	Adjust the nozzles according to the size of the glass.
The bottom of the glass is dirty.	The mark of the glass forwarding rollers can be seen on the glass.	Clean the forwarding rollers in the rinsing and drying sections!
The low-e glass is scratched.	The brushes are not clean.	Clean the brushes according to the maintenance instructions!

Error	Causes	Solution
The driving doesn't start.	The START switch is not turned on.	Start the machine with the green ON button!
	The emergency button got stuck.	Check the emergency button!
	The sensor is dirty.	Clean the sensor!
	There is a sheet of glass before the sensor.	Take away the glass from the sensor!
	The driving gear failed.	Change the driving gear!
The washing is not clean enough.	The water in the tank is not clean enough.	Change the water in the tanks!
	The water filters are dirty.	Clean the water filters!
	The air filter is dirty.	Change the air filter!
	The rubber erasers are dirty.	Clean the rubbers!
	The rollers of the outlet conveyor are dusty.	Clean the rollers!
The inlet conveyor is not working.	The chain is weak.	Check the chain!
	The wheel is rotating but the driving is not working.	Adjust the fixing of the wheels!
The outlet conveyor is not working.	The chain is weak.	Check the chain!
	The wheel is rotating but the driving is not working.	Adjust the fixing of the wheels!





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







- 1. SM70V washing machine I.






